In collaboration with our Farm Manager, you will ensure our schoolyard farms are productive and welcoming spaces. You will also provide leadership to Farm Interns and youth and adult volunteers to complete daily tasks on the farm. Together you'll help to sell our produce at the local farmer's market and prepare it for our CSA.
