Everyone should have access to healthy food, soil, and community. Fresh Roots enacts this vision by cultivating engaging gardens and programs that catalyze healthy eating, ecological stewardship, and community celebration. Fresh Roots stewards 1/2-acre market gardens on school grounds across the lower mainland. Its fields produce good food for the community, empower youth through vocational skills development, and serve as hands-on outdoor classrooms for over 5000 students each year.

The Position

If you love to be outside and to get away from the monotony of the computer, if you love sharing food with your community, or if you see the magic in sprouting seeds, this might be the position for you! The Schoolyard Farm Intern will assist the Fresh Roots Farm Manager in growing Good Food on school grounds. As part of the farm team, the Schoolyard Farm Intern will take part in crop production, field maintenance, harvesting, and produce sales. Fresh Roots Interns will have a chance to learn and work in many areas of the organization, including elementary and teen educational programming.

This is a combination of an unpaid, 252-hour internship with credit available through UBC, Kwantlen, and some other universities, and a paid, 16-week full-time position through Canada Summer Jobs. Internship hours will be worked March-May and September-November. Paid hours will be mid-May through August.

Qualifications

- Must meet [Canada Summer Jobs Requirements](#) and be able to commit full-time in the summer
- Any experience in gardening or farming is an asset
- Able to carry out a variety of tasks that involve bending, squatting, and lifting
- Happy to work outdoors in all conditions
- Team player with patience and a sense of humour (vegetable puns are encouraged)
- Able to pass a criminal record check

- UBC Credit option, 6 credits, LFS 496; Kwantlen credit option: 3 credits, AGRI 4295
- This is a 252 hour unpaid, for credit internship over two semesters, January to May and September to November. Hours per month will break down roughly as follows:
 - o March-May: 125 hours
 - o September-November: 125 hours
- The position will transition to paid, 40 hours per week for mid-May through August. Pay rate DOE, but not less than \$15.00/hour.
